one nation, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all.

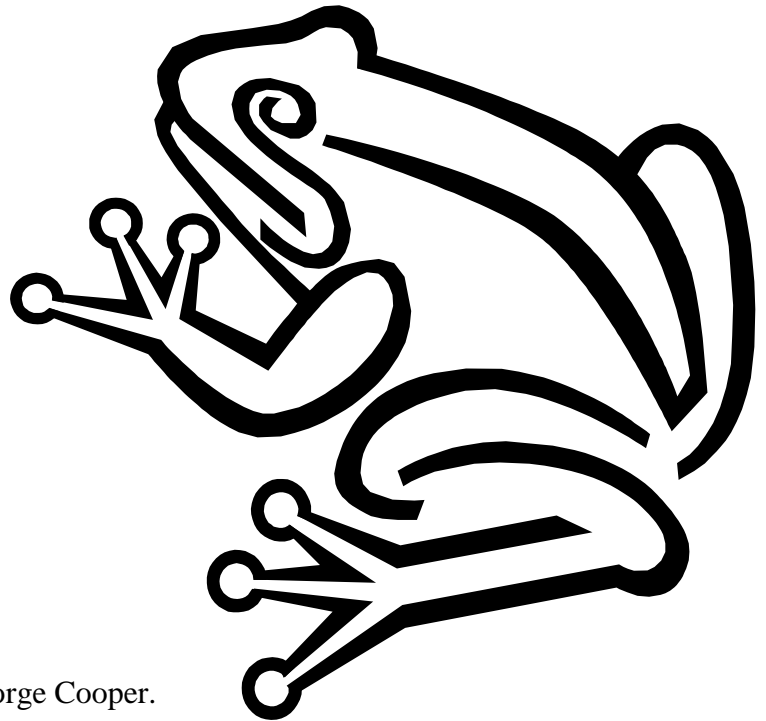
Poem:

Like a diamond in the sky.

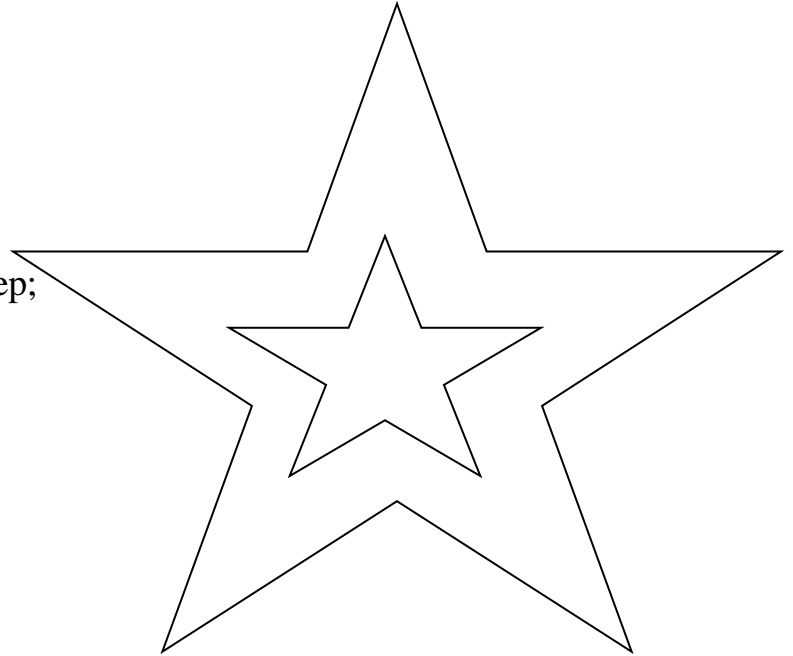
