- a. <u>House Raising</u>: social gatherings held in order to construct a house for a neighbor. The men would construct the house while the women serve dinner.
- b. <u>Rail Splitting</u>: a social gathering held in order to construct a fence for the neighbor's yard. A split-rail fence is a type of fence constructed out of logs, usually split lengthwise into "rails".
- c. <u>Hog Killing</u>: A social gathering for men. The men go hunting to kill a wild boar.
- d. <u>Land Clearing</u>: A social gathering that cleared the land surrounding a neighbor's home in order to protect the home from fire, so the family can see dangerous animals, and so the family can spot local hunting game in the sand surrounding the house.
