



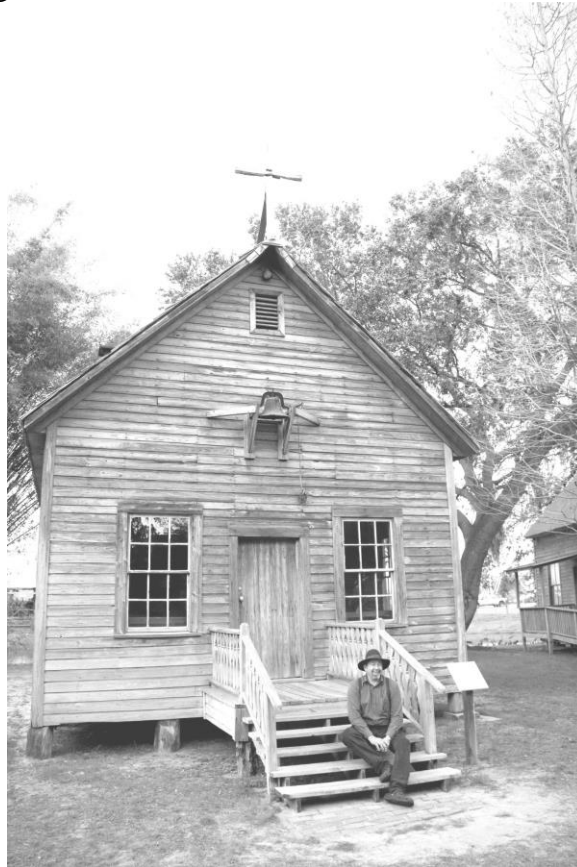

Post-Trip Lesson Plan The Church

Instructions: Read the history of the Church building at Cracker Country. Then create your own church using the historic information and the picture below. Be creative and imaginative. Once finished complete the worksheet below.

History: The Church at Cracker Country was originally built in the 1900s in Gretna, Florida, located in Gadsden County. The structure is built of heart pine lumber and served as a one room schoolhouse until 1946.

Architecture: Buildings were constructed out of wood during this time period. Churches were often one room much like school houses. Also, the buildings would not have two sided walls, meaning that the wall that you see on the outside is the wall you see on the inside; there is no drywall or paint. These buildings would not have air-conditioning but would use open windows to stay cool in the summer and a wood burning stove to keep warm in the winter. There was also no electricity in these buildings, meaning events would not be held after sun down because there would be no good lighting methods.
