

## All Aboard Vocabulary List

1. Caboose: the last car on a freight train; the crew used the caboose for cooking and sleeping; each one belonged to a specific conductor
2. Conductor: the lead employee on a train keeping the crew and passengers safe
3. Crate: a wood box used for shipping goods
4. Destination: a place where something is being sent; also a place that people want to take a special trip to visit
5. Engineer: the train driver
6. Freight: transported goods like fruit, vegetables, and household items
7. Goods: things that can be sold
8. Locomotive: a powered rail vehicle found at the front of the train used to pull train cars
9. Morse Code: a message sent using a telegraph in which letters are groupings of short and long sounds
10. Passenger: a traveler
11. Resort: a popular place to vacation; a hotel with fancy features
12. Steamboat: a boat powered by steam; a popular method of traveling to Florida before trains
13. Steam Engine: an engine that is powered by steam; both steam trains and steamboats have a steam engine
14. Telegraph: a system of sending a message from a long distance along a wire using Morse code
15. Tourist: a person visiting a place to have fun
16. Train Depot: a building from which a train arrives and departs; often containing a waiting room for passengers, office, and freight platform
